<p><b>Glass &amp; Metal</b></p> <p>Mix Glass &amp; Metal</p> <p>Clear, Green, Brown, &amp; Blue</p> <p>Aluminum &amp; Tin Cans Aerosol Cans Aluminum, Brass, Copper, Iron, Lead, or Steel</p>	<p>Light Bulbs, Dishware, Ceramics, Plastics, Window Glass, &amp; Pyrex</p> <p>Frozen Juice Cans Shortening Cans Odorous Items</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Rinse out</li> <li>• Remove caps &amp; lids</li> <li>• Labels can be left on</li> <li>• Metal caps and lids can be included in the mix</li> </ul>
<p><b>Paper Products</b></p> <p>Newsprint Magazines Catalogs Phone Books Enveloped Junk Mail Writing Paper Copy Paper Computer Paper Paper Board (examples: cereal boxes, Kleenex boxes, &amp; soda cartons)</p>	<p>Tissues</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Keep dry</li> <li>• Any newspaper insert can be recycled with the paper it came in</li> <li>• Keep paper separate from can/bottle mix</li> <li>• Can be bundled or bagged</li> </ul>
<p><b>Cardboard</b></p> <p>Corrugated Only (the cardboard with the 'wavy middle layer')</p>	<p>Styrofoam Packaging Waxed Cardboard Grease Stained Pizza Boxes</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Flatten</li> <li>• Remove tape &amp; staples</li> <li>• Do not bag or tie</li> <li>• Damp cardboard is OK</li> </ul>
<p><b>Batteries</b></p> <p>Lead Acid Batteries from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Car            - Truck</li> <li>- Tractor      - Mower</li> </ul>	<p>Disposable Batteries from:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Toys        - Flashlights</li> <li>- Clocks</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Set next to recyclables or trash</li> <li>• Do not set in trash</li> </ul>
<p><b>Motor Oil</b></p> <p>Motor Oil Transmission Oil Hydraulic Oil</p>	<p>Antifreeze</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Set out separately in unbreakable container marked "OIL"</li> <li>• Plastic jugs with screw lids are OK</li> </ul>
